Current Situation

Pakistan is facing one of the severe flooding in the history where regions like Buner, Swat, Shangla, Gilgti Baltistan (GB), and Eastern Punjab have been disproportionately affected. The climate change intensified the monsoon and has brought 26.5% more rainfall than last year in Punjab alone.

The Disaster Management Authority declared 19 districts as calamity hit regions where the death toll has risen to 854 thus far with 1,130 injuries and 6,181 livestock perished. The infrastructure has seen considerable damage where access routes are water logged, 9,159 houses and more than 677 schools are reported fully or partially damaged leaving many families homeless and facing a dire humanitarian situation.

The Disaster Management Authorities have issued evacuation alerts where in Punjab alone more 200,000 people have been evacuated to camps and some have taken shelter with relatives while others are waiting for a helping hand under the open sky.

As per the current reports, Ravi and Sutlej Rivers at Balloki and Ganda Sindh Wala are experiencing exceptional flooding. Trimmu and regions like Multan, Muzaffarh Garh, and Rajapur remains on high alert for next 24 hours.



Penny Appeal Humanitarian Response

Providing life-saving assistance during emergencies has been the niche of the Penny Appeal while providing immediate assistance in June to communities in Punjab and has initiated the response on the onset of the flood emergency in August 2025.

Realizing the immediate needs, Penny Appeal has been providing support in Rescue Operations, delivering Cooked Meals, Clean Drinking Water, Hygiene Kits, Medical Assistance, Provision of Debris Removal Kits and Debris Removal Operations to restore safe access.

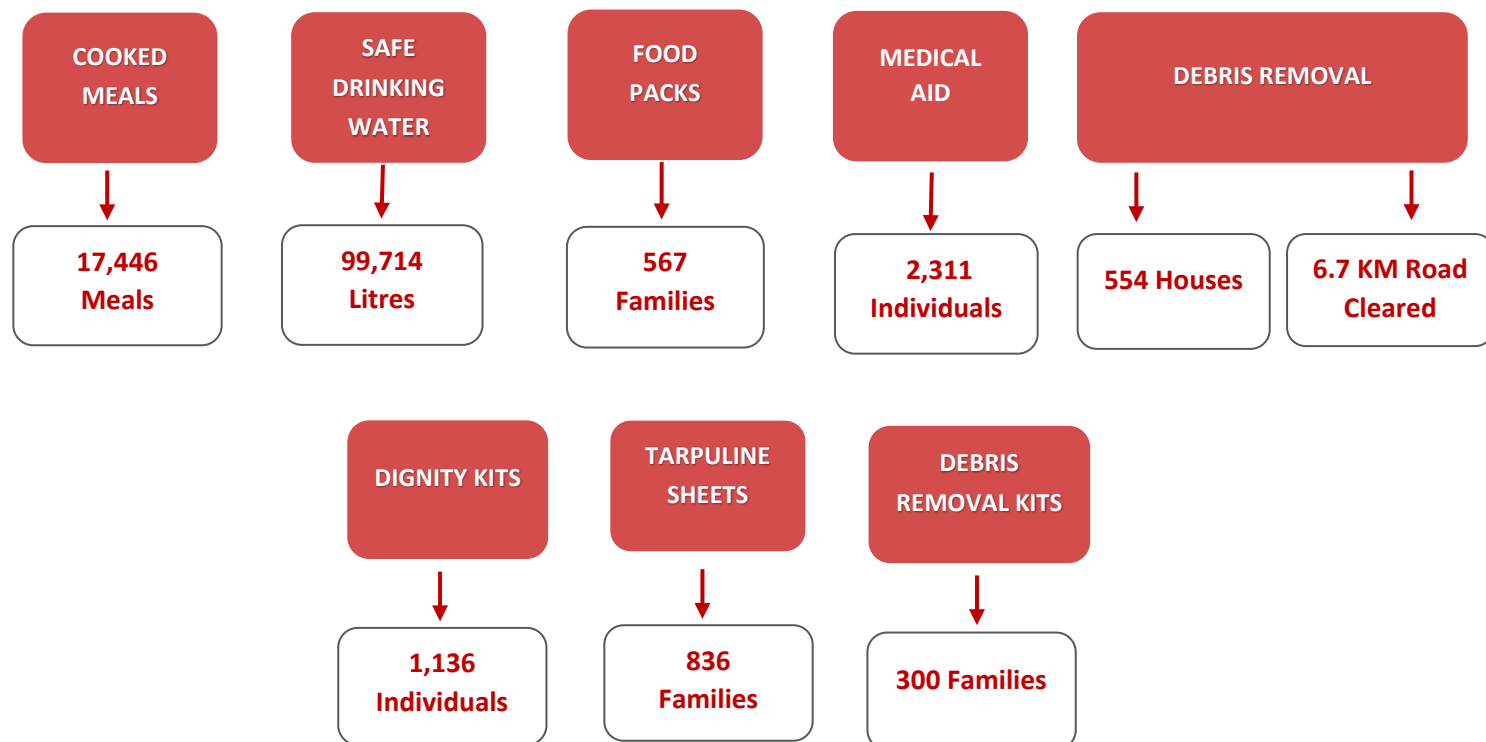
So far, Penny Appeal has provided 17,671 Fresh Meals, 99,714 Litre of Safe Drinking Water, provided Medical Aid to 2,311 people and have cleared 6.7 KM road and 554 households through Debris Removal activity. Furthermore, Penny Appeal distributed 300 Debris Removal Kits, 1,136 Hygiene/Dignity Kits, 836 Tarpuline Sheets and 567 Food Pack among flood effected families.

Penny Appeal remains committed to reaching the most vulnerable with urgent life-saving support.
