Current Situation

The declared calamity of Pakistan's 2025 monsoon season has been especially destructive to its northern regions, including Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KP) and Gilgit-Baltistan (GB). Flash floods and landslides, caused by rain since late June, have led to widespread destruction, with the most severe damage coming from heavy mid-August downpours. Disaster zones have been declared in KP districts such as Buner, Swat, and Swabi, where whole villages were swept away by powerful torrents of water and debris. The devastation is immense, resulting in a significant number of deaths and a profound effect on infrastructure and livelihoods.

This flood's human toll is a tragedy, with more than 788 people dead and 1,018 injured throughout the country. The most significant impact has been in the mountainous areas, as more than half of all deaths have occurred in KP province. Communities in places like Buner and Swat are reeling from the sudden cloudbursts, and many people are still missing, leaving families broken. The crisis has also displaced thousands, with nearly 6,630 homes damaged or destroyed, leaving many families homeless and facing a dire humanitarian situation.




Penny Appeal Humanitarian Response

Penny Appeal initiated flood response in the last week of August 2025 when the floods/cloudburst hit KPK. Currently, Penny Appeal is responding in two districts situated in KPK provinces of the country. Our major response includes providing cooked food, food packages, hygiene kits, temporary shelters, Non-food items and Medical assistance.
