Current Situation

The 2025 monsoon season has brought a declared calamity to Pakistan, particularly devastating its northern regions like Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KP) and Gilgit-Baltistan (GB). Since late June, rain-triggered flash floods and landslides have caused widespread destruction, with the heaviest downpours in mid-August proving catastrophic. Districts such as Buner, Swat, and Swabi in KP have been declared disaster zones, as entire villages were swept away by torrents of water and debris. The scale of the disaster is immense, with a significant loss of human life and a profound impact on livelihoods and infrastructure.

The human toll from these floods is a tragic one, with over 785 lives lost and more than 1,011 people injured across the country. The mountainous regions have been hit hardest, with over half of the total fatalities occurring in KP province alone. The sudden cloudbursts in areas like Buner and Swat have left communities reeling, with many people still missing and families torn apart. Beyond the immediate casualties, the crisis has displaced thousands, with nearly 4,708 homes damaged or destroyed, leaving countless families without shelter and facing a dire humanitarian situation.



Penny Appeal Humanitarian Response

Penny Appeal initiated flood response in the last week of August 2025 when the floods/cloudburst hit KPK. Currently, Penny Appeal is responding in two districts situated in KPK provinces of the country. Our major response includes providing cooked food, food packages, hygiene kits, temporary shelters, Non-food items and Medical assistance.
