#### OUR IMPACT:



#### 28,000 Hot Meals

Providing hot meals to the survivors of the devastating earthquake is critical as it can provide essential nourishment and comfort during a time of stress and uncertainty.



#### 23,400 Litres of Water

Access to clean bottled water is essential for survival, and many earthquake victims have been left with nothing due to a damaged infrastructure.



#### 600 Hygiene Dignity Kits

Hygiene and dignity kits containing basic toiletries and personal care items will help maintain hygiene and promote dignity.



#### 1000 Blankets

Warm blankets and comfort to those who have lost their homes and residing in temporary shelters.



#### 600 Heating Essentials

Heating essentials such as portable stoves or fuel are helping prevent hypothermia and provide comfort during cold conditions.

On February 6th, 2023, Turkey was struck by a 7.8 magnitude earthquake, followed by several other deadly tremors.

Collectively, these earthquakes have caused a catastrophic loss of life, with over 50,000 fatalities, and have left millions of people displaced. The World Health Organisation (WHO) estimates that 23 million individuals have been directly impacted by this tragedy.
